What Some Of You Were - Christopher Keane

This book is a bold and timely commentary on homosexuality for a distinctly Australian perspective. It combines open, honest and at times moving personal stories of those who grapple with homosexuality (their own or that of people close to them). Personal testimonies are supplemented with appendices providing impressive medical, social and theological perspectives on the issue.

Craving For Love - Briar Whitehead (revised and reprinted)

There is something for everyone here with chapters for men and women struggling with same-sex attraction as well as helpful material for wives, children, parents and much, much more. An excellent resource.

Coming Out Of Homosexuality - Bob Davis & Lori Rentzel

This practical book helps people who are dealing with same-sex desires to put their past behind them. It looks at how to form healthy relationships, how a person's past affects the present, and how to apply Biblical principles.

Growth Into Manhood - Alan Medinger

What happens when a boy grows physically into an adult male but misses some of the experiences and relationships that help him reach complete manhood? Many such boys grow up with homosexual attractions; others may be heterosexual but lack a true sense of their manhood. Alan Medinger writes for such men and for those who care for them.

Homosexuality: The Use of Scientific Research in the Church's Moral Debate - Stanton L Jones and Mark A Yarhouse

The authors, in great detail and with exceptional clarity, address the four issues on which false statements have often carried the day: How common is homosexuality, what causes it, is it changeable, and is it harmful. They declare up front that they are on the side of traditional Christian teaching, they examine each question with utmost fairness.

Someone I Love is Gay - Anita Worthen & Bob Davis

Finding out that a child, spouse, relative or friend is homosexual can be a devastating experience. What do you say? What should your responses be? This book was created out of Anita Worthen's struggle over these issues with her son. This is a 'must' read for anyone who wants to respond to their gay loved-one in a Biblical and loving way.

Straight And Narrow? - Thomas Schmidt

In this significant book Thomas Schmidt listens attentively to the emotionally charged arguments on both sides of the homosexual debate. He looks again at the Bible, and at tradition and contemporary experience, and forms a new Christian response which is at once compassionate and Biblical.

Healing Wounds Of The Past - Don Schmierer

Pain is certainly a part of our lives, and there are very few people who haven't, at some point, been deeply hurt. The stories in this book are moving and the applications from the Bible are powerful.

Out Of Egypt - Jeanette Howard
